Hunt Companies, through its subsidiary Ford Island Housing LLC, acquired the leasehold interest to The Waterfront at Pu‘uloa in 2003 as part of a unique land exchange with the Navy. Hunt undertook the effort to revitalize the property’s homes, which were in various states of disrepair, and has spent more than \$77 million on renovations and improvements.

A beach restoration project is also planned for the area, in which Hunt will oversee the design and restoration of the sandy beach, which has receded due to ongoing erosion.

Hunt’s renovations to the homes included new kitchens, bathrooms, appliances, windows, doors and flooring. The exterior renovations included new paint schemes, fencing, landscaping, sprinkler systems and architectural updates. The Waterfront at Pu‘uloa is a thriving community of just under 6,000 residents and is currently at 94 percent occupancy. Approximately half the homes are rented to

U.S. military members, while the other half are rented to civilians.
